Capitol Police Arrest Dover Man Who Resisted Arrest

On March 8, Delaware Capitol Police arrested David L. Steller, 37, of Dover on charges of felony resisting arrest and third-degree reckless endangering. On March 7, Sellers was contacted by a Capitol Police officer in the roadway near Family Court in Dover in reference to an investigation. While the officer was speaking with Sellers he drove off in his vehicle and the officer was dragged by the vehicle approximately eight to ten feet before Steller left the scene. Steller was identified and a warrant was obtained for his arrest. He was later contacted and turned himself in. Steller was arraigned at Justice of the Peace Court 7 and released on \$3000.00 secured bond pending a future appearance. The officer did not receive any injuries in the incident.
