**Owner of Rehoboth Restaurant Accused of
Selling Alcohol without a License Faces Several Charges**

Suspect and Charge Information:

Kenneth P. Heaps, 44 of Bel Air, MD was charged with:

- Selling Alcoholic Beverages without a License
- Illegal Storage of Alcoholic Beverages
- Deceptive Advertising of Alcoholic Beverages by Non-Licensee

Date of Arrest: September 21, 2011

Location: Mallory Square Fish House & Grill, 22 Wilmington Avenue, Rehoboth, DE

On September 18, the Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Enforcement (DATE) received information that Kenneth P. Heaps, owner of Mallory Fish House and Grill, had been selling liquor at this restaurant without a valid license. When DATE began its investigation, agents were able to confirm that the location does not have a valid liquor license.

During an undercover investigation, it was revealed that alcohol was being sold on the premises without a valid liquor license. A search warrant was executed by DATE Agents and Heaps was arrested on three charges including selling alcohol without a license and illegal storage of alcoholic beverages. He was later released pending trial.
