**DIVISION OF GAMING ENFORCEMENT ARRESTS MAN ACCUSED
IN INTERNAL THEFT AT DOVER CASINO**

Location: Dover Downs, Dover, DE

Date of Occurrence: March 1, 2011

Suspect: Andrew L. McCoy, 53, Smyrna, DE

A 53-year-old Smyrna man accused in an internal theft scheme at Dover Downs was arrested Tuesday. As a result of an ongoing investigation, Delaware Division of Gaming Enforcement detectives and Delaware State Police Troop 3 Evidence Detection Unit detectives searched the residence of Andrew L. McCoy. McCoy, who was the Director of Hotel Accounting at Dover Downs, was the focus of an internal theft that occurred at the Casino over the past three years. The thefts related to four separate ongoing schemes involving cash transactions.

During the search of McCoy's residence, computers and financial records were seized. McCoy was charged with three counts of felony theft, one count of misdemeanor theft and four counts of falsifying business records. He was arraigned and released on unsecured bond and is banned from all Delaware casinos.
