DIVISION OF GAMING ENFORCEMENT ARRESTS MAN ACCUSED OF STEALING CHIPS AT DELAWARE PARK

Location: Delaware Park, Newark

Date of Occurrence: Monday, August 27, 2012

Suspect: Kevin M. Davis, 21, Newark, DE

A 21-year-old Newark man was arrested in connection with the theft of \$8,500 in gaming chips from Delaware Park. On Monday, the Delaware Division of Gaming Enforcement (DGE) arrested Kevin M. Davis of Newark for felony theft in connection with an incident that occurred on August 23, 2012 at Delaware Park. Davis is accused of reaching over a plexiglass barrier at a roulette table, grabbing (17) \$500 gaming chips totaling \$8,500, and fleeing the casino through an emergency door. Delaware State Troopers and Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Enforcement Agents who are assigned to DGE, with the assistance of Delaware Park Security, identified Davis as the suspect in the theft. A search warrant was executed at Davis' home which resulted in the recovery of the gaming chips. Davis was arraigned at JP Court 11 and released on \$1,500 secured bond pending a preliminary hearing. The Newark Police Department also assisted with this case.
