### **Capitol Police Make Arrests at Division of Motor Vehicles**

On June 2, a Delaware Capitol Police officer on duty at the Georgetown Division of Motor Vehicles arrested Scott Dervaes Jr., 42, of Lewes. Dervaes was attempting to enter the DMV office through a door after the business had closed. The officer told Dervaes several times that the DMV office was closed and he was asked to step out of the doorway. Dervaes refused to comply and would not let the officer shut the door. When the officer attempted to arrest Dervaes, a struggle ensued. He was eventually placed into custody and arrested on charges of disorderly conduct and resisting arrest, both misdemeanors. He was arraigned at Justice of the Peace Court 3 and released on his own recognizance pending a future court appearance.

On June 2, Capitol Police arrested Jonathan Yenchik, 32, of Dover for criminal mischief. Mr. Yenchik and his mother were involved in a verbal dispute inside his mother's vehicle in the parking lot of the Dover DMV. During the dispute, Mr. Yenchik began punching the dashboard and windshield areas of the vehicle subsequently damaging the windshield. Mr. Yenchik was arrested and arraigned at Justice Peace 7 where he was released on unsecured bond and with a no contact order for the victim.
