Capitol Police Make Two Arrests

On June 30, Capitol Police arrested a 57-year-old Dover man accused of trespassing on State property. Charles Hawkins was charged with trespass after he was found hiding between two buildings at 89 Kings Highway Dover. Hawkins was previously found to be sleeping on State property after hours and was warned. When Gettier Security found Hawkins' property on June 30 at 3 p.m., Capitol Police was contacted. Capitol Police located Hawkins at 10:50 pm when he was found hiding. He was released with a criminal summons pending a future court appearance.

On June 30, Capitol Police arrested a 30-year-old Dover man who is a fugitive from Maryland. Timothy C. Jernigan was at the Dover Probation and Parole Office when it was discovered that he was wanted for violating probation in Maryland for a manslaughter charge. Probation and Parole contacted Capitol Police who then arrested Jernigan on charges of being a fugitive from another state. He was sent to James T. Vaughn Correctional Center by JP Court 7 having signed a waiver to fight extradition when he moved from Maryland to Delaware.
