**DIVISION OF GAMING ENFORCEMENT ARRESTS MAN
ACCUSED IN CARD MARKING SCHEME PARK**



Location: Delaware Park, Newark; Dover Downs, Dover

Date of Occurrence: December 15, 2011

Suspect: Wei Ming Li, 46, Brooklyn, NY

A 46-year-old New York man, accused of taking part in a card marking scheme at two Delaware casinos, was arrested last week. On December 15, Delaware State Police (DSP) Detectives assigned to the Delaware Division of Gaming Enforcement (DGE) arrested Li on outstanding warrants in connection with a team card marking scheme that targeted Dover Downs and Delaware Park. The scheme was conducted at Dover Downs late last year and Delaware Park in May 2011.

Li was identified as the leader of an organized cheating group that operated out of New York and San Francisco. Other members of the cheating group were arrested by DGE and prosecuted earlier this year. Li was arrested for the following felonies: cheating a table game: theft over \$1,500; and conspiracy. Li also faces the following misdemeanor charges: manipulating component of a table game; attempted theft, conspiracy, and criminal mischief. He was arraigned at Justice of the Peace Court 7 and posted a \$1,000 cash bond. He was ordered to have no contact with all Delaware Casinos.

The New York City Police Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigation's New York City Field Office also assisted with this investigation.
