**DIVISION OF GAMING ENFORCEMENT ARRESTS MAN ACCUSED  
OF ATTEMPTED THEFT AT HARRINGTON CASINO**

**Location:** Harrington Raceway and Casino, Harrington, DE

**Date of Occurrence:** February 10, 2011

**Suspect:** Timothy Stevens, 47, Queen Anne, MD

A 47-year-old Maryland man accused of attempting to remove chips from closed gaming tables was arrested Thursday. Timothy Stevens was observed attempting to break into the "chip float" on two closed gaming tables. Gaming table floats are used to store and secure chips when the game is closed.

Stevens fled the casino but was identified by Harrington casino personnel from a prior disorderly conduct incident in which he was arrested and barred. He was arrested by Delaware State Police Detectives assigned to the Division of Gaming Enforcement and charged with two counts of attempted theft, criminal trespass, and breach of bond. He was also wanted for failing to appear on a disorderly conduct charge out of J. P. Court # 6. Stevens was released on \$3,000 unsecured bond with a no contact order with Harrington Raceway & Casino pending trial at a later date.

On 01/25/2011, Stevens was caught by a Harrington pit employee attempting to break into the "chip float" on two different closed gaming tables. Stevens was able to flee. Stevens was identified by Harrington personnel from a prior Disorderly Conduct incident which he was arrested and barred. On 02/10/2011, Stevens was arrested by Delaware State Police Detectives assigned to the Division of Gaming Enforcement and charged with 2 counts of Attempted Theft (F), Criminal Trespass 3<sup>rd</sup> (V), Breach of Condition of Bond (M), and Local Fugitive for failing to appear on a Disorderly Conduct charge out of J. P. Court # 6. Stevens was released on \$3,000 unsecured bond with a no contact order with Harrington Raceway & Casino pending trial at a later date.
