Capitol Police Charge Dover Man with Offensive Touching

A Dover man accused of grabbing and pushing a woman in the parking lot of the Williams Service Center in Dover was arrested and charged with offensive touching. Delaware Capitol Police arrested Darryl C. Sheppard, 55, of Dover after responding to a report of a domestic incident in the parking lot of the Williams Service Center. Sheppard allegedly was involved in a physical altercation with the woman while the two argued in a vehicle occupied by two young children. When the woman attempted to leave, Sheppard is accused of grabbing the victim, pushing her against the vehicle and preventing her from leaving. He was also charged with unlawful imprisonment and two counts of endangering the welfare of a child. He was released on unsecured bond and ordered to have no contact with the victims.
